HULI PAC **strongly supports** <u>HB2021</u>, which removes the Legislature's exemption from the State's sunshine laws. <u>HB2635</u> & <u>SB2281</u> Establish a continuous Legislature by requiring the Legislature to convene at least once a month. Taking more time to develop bills while making members of the Legislature subject to the sunshine law. Prohibits members of the Legislature from having employment other than their work as members of the Legislature.

These bills together will bring more transparency and create an actual democratic policy-making process for the residents of Hawai'i. We have watched closed-door dealings occur at the last hour to witness many very good bills disappear or killed after being fully supported until the end. The Cesspool and the Clean Election bills during past legislative seasons are perfect examples.
